Based on the information obtained and reviewed during the course of the investigation, the conclusion of the staffing/review team is the following: The investigation has determined that Officer Fuentes observed the juvenile subject in a residential area during school hours and armed with a knife. The subject refused to obey police commands to drop the knife and advanced toward Officer Fuentes. When a taser did not stop the subject, Officer Fuentes felt it necessary to discharge his firearm.


It is reasonable to believe that the Officer Fuentes considered it necessary to use deadly force to prevent injury to himself and others.

We find that Officer Adalberto Fuentes (30-7132) was legally justified in the use of force by firing his weapon.
