Based on the information obtained and reviewed during the course of the investigation, the conclusion of the staffing/review team is the following:

After a thorough review of the evidence and applicable law, we believe that pursuant to Fla. Stats. §§ 776.012 and 776.05(1) the actions of MDPD Officer Calderon were legally justified and no charges should be filed. This incident was video recorded in its entirety. A review of the video shows that Arcadio Hernandez-Rivera was in the street and armed with a machete when MDPD Officer Calderon arrived, responding to a 911 call. The video also shows that upon his arrival, Mr. Hernandez-Rivera threatened Officer Calderon with the machete. For over three minutes, Officer Calderon tried to de-escalate the situation and talked to Mr. Hernandez-Rivera asking him to drop the machete. A second responding officer used his taser. However, Mr. Hernandez-Rivera never dropped the machete and just before being shot charged towards Officer Calderon. The members of the staffing/review team for this case are:
